1 moves to amend the bill on page 6, lines 24-25, by inserting the following language between
2 those lines:
3 **"CLARIFY COASTAL STORM DAMAGE MITIGATION FUNDING**
4 **SECTION 9.5.** Notwithstanding any provision of Section 3.1 of S.L. 2018-134 to
5 the contrary, funds appropriated to the Hurricane Florence Disaster Recovery Fund and allocated
6 to the Department of Environmental Quality for the Coastal Storm Damage Mitigation Fund
7 (Fund) by any act of the General Assembly may be used for coastal storm damage in any county
8 designated under a major disaster declaration by the President of the United States under the
9 Stafford Act (P.L. 93-288) with respect to any natural disaster occurring after January 1, 2016
10 causing damage to the ocean beaches and dune systems in that county. No recipient of funds
11 described by this section shall be required to determine which major disaster caused particular
12 coastal storm damage."
