GOVERNOR ROY COOPER OBJECTIONS AND VETO MESSAGE:

Senate Bill 320, "AN ACT TO FOSTER REGIONAL COOPERATION FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE AMONGST SYSTEMS UTILIZING RESERVOIR WATER."

Local governments have an important duty to resolve differences between themselves and ensure fair access to vital resources like water for their residents. However, they should not use state law to seek an unfair advantage in negotiations.

Therefore, I veto the bill.


