Short Title: Public Records/Release of LEO Recordings. (Public)

5 PURPOSES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 132-1.4A(h) reads as rewritten:

8 "(h) Release of Recordings; Law Enforcement Purposes. – Notwithstanding the
9 requirements of subsections (c), (f), and (g) of this section, a custodial law enforcement agency
10 shall disclose or release a recording to a district attorney (i) for review of potential criminal
11 charges, (ii) in order to comply with discovery requirements in a criminal prosecution, (iii) for
12 use in criminal proceedings in district court, or (iv) for any other law enforcement purpose, and
13 may may, in its sole discretion, disclose or release a recording for any of the following purposes:

- 14 (1) For law enforcement training purposes.
15 (2) Within the custodial law enforcement agency for any administrative, training,
16 or law enforcement purpose.
17 (3) To another law enforcement agency for law enforcement purposes.
18 (4) For the purpose of suspect identification or apprehension.
19 (5) For noncriminal investigative purposes such as community-oriented publicity
20 or goodwill."

21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
