11 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the Board of Trustees of a constituent  
12 institution of The University of North Carolina elects to do so, it may by resolution adopted  
13 consider as residents of North Carolina all persons who receive full scholarships, unless the  
14 scholarship is for athletics, to the institution from entities recognized by the institution and attend  
15 the institution as undergraduate students. ~~The aforesaid persons shall be considered residents of~~  
16 ~~North Carolina for all purposes by The University of North Carolina.~~

17 (a1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the Board of Trustees of a constituent  
18 institution of The University of North Carolina elects to do so, it may adopt an annual resolution  
19 to consider as residents of North Carolina all persons who receive full scholarships for athletics  
20 to the institution from entities recognized by the institution and attend the institution as  
21 undergraduate students. An entity may be recognized by the institution only if that entity has  
22 endowments totaling less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000).

23 (b) The following definitions apply in this section:

- 24 (1) "Full cost" means an amount calculated by the constituent institution that is  
25 no less than the sum of tuition, required fees, and on-campus room and board.  
26 (2) "Full scholarship" means a grant that meets the full cost for a student to attend  
27 the constituent institution for an academic year.

28 (c) This section shall not be applied in any manner that violates federal law.

29 (d) This section shall be administered by the electing constituent institution so as to have  
30 no fiscal impact.

31 (e) In administering this section, the electing constituent institution shall maintain at least  
32 the current number of North Carolina residents admitted to that constituent institution.
