Senator Smith

1 moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 19-22, by deleting those lines and substituting the  
2 following new language to read:

4           "(3) Cybersecurity Upgrades (Fund Code: 1720) – One million forty-four thousand  
5 six hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$1,044,679) in recurring funds for each  
6 fiscal year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium to provide funds for the  
7 continuing upgrade of statewide cybersecurity capabilities. Twelve million  
8 dollars (\$12,000,000) in nonrecurring funds over the 2019-2021 fiscal  
9 biennium for the Department to provide directed grants in both years in the  
10 total amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to each institution of the  
11 following four-year and two-year collaborative cohorts of National Security  
12 Agency certified Cybersecurity and Information Technology Centers of  
13 Excellence: (i) Montreat College, in cohort with The University of North  
14 Carolina at Charlotte; (ii) Salem College, in cohort with Forsyth Technical  
15 Community College; (iii) Meredith College, in cohort with North Carolina  
16 State University; (iv) Fayetteville State University, in cohort with Fayetteville  
17 Technical Community College; (v) Guilford Technical Community College,  
18 in cohort with North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University;  
19 and (vi) Elizabeth City State University, in cohort with East Carolina  
20 University.";

21  
22 and on page 3, lines 40-43, by deleting those lines and substituting the following new language  
23 to read:

25           "(7) Apprenticeship Program (Fund Code: 1720) – Four million dollars  
26 (\$4,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for each fiscal year of the 2019-2021 fiscal  
27 biennium for the Department of Information Technology's apprenticeship  
28 program for the purpose of building the State's cybersecurity workforce  
29 capacity and addressing future cybersecurity needs.";

31 and by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
