10	(a) Rule Adoption Required. – The Environmental Management Com	mission shall adopt
11	permanent rules and may adopt temporary rules applicable to High Flow notif	ications for releases
12	from dams located in the State and licensed by the Federal Energy Regu	latory Commission
13	(FERC). The rules shall apply only to dams that are (i) associated with a hydro	oelectric generating
14	station also licensed by FERC and (ii) located adjacent to or less than two m	niles upstream from
15	either the corporate limits of a city with a population greater than 500,000 or	the boundaries of a
16	county of the State with a population greater than 750,000.	
17	(b) Content of Required Rules. – The rules required by this section sha	all, to the extent not
18	inconsistent with existing FERC rules, require the FERC licensee to provide	notification to local
19	first responders and emergency management personnel serving an impacted	l area at least three
20	hours prior to high flow releases for which a High Flow notification is requi	red by FERC rules.
21	The rules may provide for a shorter period for the advance notification	if needed to avoid
22	significant damage to the dam or associated hydroelectric generating station.	
23	(c) <u>Definition. – For purposes of this section, "impacted area" is the a</u>	area downstream of
24	the dam where flooding due to the high flow has the potential to cause loss	ss of human life or
25	significant damage to property."	
26	SECTION 2. The sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) is	
27	nonrecurring basis for the 2020-2021 fiscal year from the General Fund	to the Division of
28	Emergency Management of the Department of Public Safety for the develop
