Article to rea	ECTION 1. Chapter 147 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a r	iew

"§ 147-33.125. North Carolina Surgeon General; appointment, duties, and salary.			
(a) There is established the position of North Carolina Surgeon General for the State of			
North Carolina. The Governor shall appoint a North Carolina Surgeon General to serve as the			
State's chief public health advocate. The North Carolina Surgeon General shall serve for a term			
of four years, to run concurrently with the term of the Governor. Beginning January 1, 2024, the			
appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. The North Carolina Surgeon General			
may be appointed to consecutive terms.			
(b) The Surgeon General shall report directly to the Governor and shall work closely with			
the Secretary of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (Secretary) to			
ensure compliance with the strategic plans, policies, and implementation activities of the			
Department of Health and Human Services (Department). The Department shall provide			
adequate staff and other support as needed.(c) The North Carolina Surgeon General shall advise the Governor and the Secretary on			
(c) The North Carolina Surgeon General shall advise the Governor and the Secretary on health policy and be a key spokesperson for the State on public health issues throughout the State			
by providing North Carolina residents with the best medical and scientific evidence on current			
health issues through public health reports and other tools of public communication.

7	Office of the Governor, in accordance with G.S. 147-33.125.
