4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors
6 of The University of North Carolina sums sufficient in recurring and nonrecurring funds for the
7 2020-2021 fiscal year for the Building Reserve to be used for operation and maintenance of the
8 following building projects:

34 **SECTION 2.** The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General
35 Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act
36 by reference.

1 **SECTION 3.** Except where expressly repealed or amended by this act, the provisions
2 of any other legislation enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly
3 expressly appropriating funds to an agency, a department, or an institution covered under this
4 act, shall remain in effect.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
