Short Title: Repurpose Pre-Regulatory Landfill Funds. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REVISE MATCHING REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE FUNDING OF
3 REMEDIATION ACTIVITIES AT THE CHARLOTTE MOTOR SPEEDWAY.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 **SECTION 1.** Section 13.2 of S.L. 2018-5, as amended by Section 4.2 of S.L.
6 2018-97, reads as rewritten:
7 "**SECTION 13.2.** Notwithstanding G.S. 130A-310.11(b), up to two million dollars
8 (\$2,000,000) of the funds credited to the Inactive Hazardous Sites Cleanup Fund under
9 G.S. 105-187.63 for the assessment and remediation of pre-1983 landfills shall instead be used
10 by the Department of Environmental Quality's Division of Waste Management to provide a
11 matching grant to Charlotte Motor Speedway, LLC, (CMS) for the purpose of remediation
12 activities at the Charlotte Motor Speedway in Cabarrus County. The Division shall provide one
13 dollar (\$1.00) for every ~~two one non-State dollars (\$2.00)~~ dollar (\$1.00) provided in kind or
14 otherwise, up to a maximum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the matching grant described
15 in this section. CMS may allocate all or a portion of the grant provided by this section to an entity
16 that controls CMS or an entity controlled by CMS. Entities receiving such an allocation shall be
17 considered a subgrantee as defined in G.S. 143C-6-23."
18 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
