Short Title: (Public) DMV/Title/Reg./Modified Utility Vehicle. Representative Dixon. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TITLE AND REGISTRATION OF MODIFIED UTILITY VEHICLES FOR USE ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-4.01(27) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to read: Modified utility vehicle. – A motor vehicle that is (i) designed for off-road use and (ii) manufactured with equipment required by G.S. 20-121.1(2). "Modified utility vehicle" does not include an all-terrain vehicle, golf cart, or utility vehicle, as defined in this section, or a riding lawn mower." **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-87(12) reads as rewritten: "(12) Low-Speed Vehicles and Mini-Trucks. Vehicles, Mini-Trucks, and Modified <u>Utility Vehicles.</u> – The fee for a low-speed vehicle or mini truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle is the same as the fee for private passenger vehicles of not more than 15 passengers. However, the fee for any low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle that is offered for rent shall be the same as the fee for a U-drive-it automobile." **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-121.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 20-121.1. Operation of a low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle on certain roadways. The operation of a low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle is authorized with the following restrictions: A low-speed vehicle may be operated only on streets and highways where the (1) posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less. A modified utility vehicle may be operated only on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 55 miles per hour or less. A mini-truck may be operated only on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 55 miles per hour or less. This does not prohibit a low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle from crossing a road or street at an intersection where the road or street being crossed has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour. A low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility (2) vehicle shall be equipped with headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, tail lamps, reflex reflectors, parking brakes, rearview mirrors, windshields,



windshield wipers, speedometer, seat belts, and a vehicle identification

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
