A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PUBLIC ENTITIES IN GRANVILLE COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality the sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated to the Division of Water Infrastructure to provide a grant to the South Granville Water and Sewer Authority for water and wastewater infrastructure projects.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated to the Division of Health Service Regulation to provide a grant to Granville Health, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, to support Granville Emergency Medical Services.

**SECTION 3.(a)** There is transferred from the General Fund to the State Capital and Infrastructure Fund the sum of twenty-one million five hundred thirty-seven thousand three hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$21,537,358) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

**SECTION 3.(b)** There is appropriated from the State Capital and Infrastructure Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of twenty-one million five hundred thirty-seven thousand three hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$21,537,358) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, to be allocated as follows:

- \$14,143,141 to the local school administrative unit in Granville County, to be (1) used for new construction or rehabilitation of existing facilities and repairs and renovations.
- \$7,394,217 to Vance-Granville Community College, to be used for new (2) construction or rehabilitation of existing facilities and repairs and renovations.

**SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
