1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE WORKFORCE HOUSING LOAN PROGRAM
3	ADMINISTERED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. By August 15, 2020, the State Controller shall deposit the sum of ten
6	million dollars (\$10,000,000) in the General Fund from the cash balance in the Federal Insurance
7	Contributions Act (FICA) Fund (Budget Code: 24160; Fund Code: 2000).
8	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 58-6-25, effective for the
9	insurance regulatory charge levied during the 2020-2021 fiscal year and due and collected after
10	the effective date of this act, the General Fund shall be credited the sum of ten million dollars
11	(\$10,000,000) from the proceeds of the charge that would be credited to the Insurance Regulatory
12	Fund.
13	SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina
14	Housing Finance Agency (Budget Code: 13010; Fund Code: 1100) the sum of twenty million
15	dollars (\$20,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year. The funds shall be
16	used for the Workforce Housing Loan Program in accordance with G.S. 122A-5.15. Funds
17	appropriated in this section shall be fully allocated during the 2020 housing credit award cycle.
18	SECTION 4. The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General
19	Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act
20	by reference.
21	SECTION 5. Except where expressly repealed or amended by this act, the provisions
22	of any other legislation enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly
23	expressly appropriating funds to an agency, a department, or an institution covered under this act
24	shall remain in effect.
25	SECTION 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
