Sponsors: Referred to: May 19, 2020 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN AVERY, BLADEN, HOKE, 3 MONTGOMERY, AND YADKIN COUNTIES. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.(a)** The office of coroner in Montgomery County is abolished. 6 Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to SECTION 1.(b) 7 Montgomery County. 8 **SECTION 2.(a)** The office of coroner is abolished. 9 **SECTION 2.(b)** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable. **SECTION 2.(c)** This section applies only in the following counties: Avery, Bladen, 10 Hoke, and Yadkin Counties. 11 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding Section 2 of this act, any coroner elected in the 2018 12 or 2020 general election shall serve the remainder of their term. If a vacancy occurs in the office 13 14 of coroner, a person may be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term. **SECTION 4.** Sections 2 and 3 of this act become effective January 1, 2021. The 15 remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law. 16
