  - 19          g. A student identification card issued by a constituent institution of The  
20 University of North Carolina, a community college, as defined in  
21 G.S. 115D-2(2), ~~or an~~ eligible private postsecondary institution as  
22 defined in G.S. 116-280(3), ~~provided that card is issued in accordance~~  
23 ~~with G.S. 163-166.17, a North Carolina public high school, or a~~  
24 ~~nonpublic school that meets the requirements of Part 1 or Part 2 of~~  
25 ~~Article 39 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes.~~
  - 26          h. An employee identification card issued by a state or local government  
27 entity, including a charter school, provided that card is issued in  
28 accordance with G.S. 163-166.18.
  - 29          i. A drivers license or special identification card for nonoperators issued  
30 by another state, the District of Columbia, or a territory or  
31 commonwealth of the United States, but only if the voter's voter  
32 registration was within 90 days of the election.";


