Senator Brown

moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 14-15, by inserting between those lines the following new language to read:

"SECTION 1.(c) Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-8-13, or any other provision of law to the contrary, of the funds appropriated in subsection (b) of this section, the Office of State Budget and Management shall allocate the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) in nonrecurring funds in accordance with the following:

(1) \$2,500,000 to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources for contextual signage for existing monuments on the State Capitol grounds and additional monuments representing the lives and contributions of African-Americans in the State, as recommended by the North Carolina Historical Commission.

 \$1,500,000 as a directed grant to the North Carolina Freedom Monument Project, Inc., to build a public sculpture park on land located between the Legislative Building and the Governor's Mansion in downtown Raleigh to commemorate historic and ongoing struggles for freedom in North Carolina and especially the enduring roles of African-Americans in the struggle for freedom in this State. These funds shall not be expended unless the North Carolina Freedom Monument Project, Inc., raises the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) in non-State funds to match the funds allocated under this subdivision.";

and on page 1, line 15, by deleting that line and substituting the following new language to read: "SECTION 2.(a) Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act that remain after the allocations provided in subsection (c) of Section 1 of this act, the following".
