5 litigants who are appropriately registered in the electronic filing system may file electronically  
6 in accordance with Rule 5 of the General Rules of Practice for the Superior and District Courts.";

8 And on page 4, lines 1-5, by rewriting the lines the read:

10           "(3) The failure to affix a date stamp or file stamp on any order or judgment filed  
11           in a civil action, estate proceeding, or special proceeding shall not affect the  
12           sufficiency, validity, or enforceability of the order or judgment if the clerk or  
13           the court, after giving the parties adequate notice and opportunity to be heard,  
14           enters the order or judgment nunc pro tunc to the date of filing.""
