1 moves to amend the bill on page 18, line 25, by deleting "SECTION 5.2." and substituting
2 "SECTION 5.2.(a)"; and

4 on page 18, lines 38-39, by inserting the following between the lines:

5 "SECTION 5.2.(b) Notwithstanding the limitation on contract commitments in G.S.
6 143C-6-11(f), when the Department's cash balance is below the 7.5% required by that subsection,
7 upon approval of the Secretary of Transportation, the Department may enter into transportation
8 project contract commitments that are necessary to restore transportation infrastructure damaged
9 as a result of a natural disaster or other emergency. Within 72 hours of entering into a contract
10 under this subsection, the Secretary shall report to the Board of Transportation, the
11 Transportation Oversight Manager at the Office of State Budget and Management, and the Joint
12 Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee, detailing the need for the contract and the
13 associated costs.

14 SECTION 5.3.(c) Subsection (b) of this section expires on January 1, 2021."; and

16 by amending Amendment #1, on page 2, lines 22-23, of the amendment by rewriting the lines to
17 read:

19 "~~section~~section, and in a manner that ensures to the extent practicable that the funds are eligible
20 for federal reimbursement or cost sharing with the federal funds.""; and".
