No municipality or county shall deny or revoke a reasonable permit for a parade, or firework display discharged in accordance with Article 54 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes, scheduled to occur between 5:00 P.M. on July 1st and 5:00 P.M. on July 10th. For a municipality or county to revoke or deny a permit that is substantially the same as a permit that was approved for a parade or fireworks display that was scheduled to be held between 5:00 P.M. on July 1st, 2019, and 5:00 P.M. on July 10th, 2019, a finding of good cause by the governing board is required, and the finding must be documented in writing.";
