1 **"SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law, and applies to any parades
2 or firework displays scheduled to occur between 5:00 P.M. on July 1st and on 5:00 P.M. July
3 10th. Except as otherwise provided, this act expires when any applicable declaration of
4 emergency prohibitions and restrictions on parades and firework displays scheduled to occur
5 between 5:00 P.M. on July 1st and 5:00 P.M. on July 10th, expire or are terminated."
