Page 1 of 2 Amends Title [NO] .2020 Fourth Edition Senator Van Duyn moves to amend the bill on page 40, line 21, by rewriting the line to read: "facilities, which includes, but is not limited to: Adhering to all COVID-19 health and safety guidance for schools. a. Ensuring that at least one person currently certified in First Aid and b. cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) appropriate for school-age children is present at the program any time children are present. Ensuring that all staff and volunteers obtain and successfully pass a <u>c.</u> criminal background check performed by the Department that includes a check of the child abuse and neglect registry. Notifying local health authorities of confirmed COVID-19 cases <u>d.</u> among children and staff. Notifying parents or guardians of any child who becomes ill or who is <u>e.</u> suspected of being ill with a communicable condition or who has sustained any injury during care. Obtaining and successfully passing building, fire, and sanitation <u>f.</u> inspections within three months of opening or at the soonest date the inspection can be scheduled by the inspecting agency, whichever occurs first. For purposes of this subdivision, the following definitions shall"; and on page 40, lines 32, by deleting the word "three" and substituting "five"; and on page 40, line 35, by removing the quotation marks on that line; and on page 40, lines 35 & 36, by inserting between those lines the following: "(4) The Department shall not incur liability for any loss or damages resulting from community-based organizations that provide care to children and are or should be registered with the Department pursuant to this section."; and

on page 41, line 1, by rewriting the line to read:
