2 moves to amend the bill on page 40, line 21, by rewriting the line to read:

4 "facilities, which includes, but is not limited to:

- 5 a. Adhering to all COVID-19 health and safety guidance for schools.
- 6 b. Ensuring that at least one person currently certified in First Aid and
7 cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) appropriate for school-age
8 children is present at the program any time children are present.
- 9 c. Ensuring that all staff and volunteers obtain and successfully pass a
10 criminal background check performed by the Department that includes
11 a check of the child abuse and neglect registry.
- 12 d. Notifying local health authorities of confirmed COVID-19 cases
13 among children and staff.
- 14 e. Notifying parents or guardians of any child who becomes ill or who is
15 suspected of being ill with a communicable condition or who has
16 sustained any injury during care.
- 17 f. Obtaining and successfully passing building, fire, and sanitation
18 inspections within three months of opening or at the soonest date the
19 inspection can be scheduled by the inspecting agency, whichever
20 occurs first.
