1 moves to amend the bill on page 17, lines 23-~~25~~, by rewriting the lines to read:

3 "(114e) \$23,000,000 to OSBM, one-half to be allocated to North Carolina Health
4 Care Facilities Association (NCHCFA) and one-quarter each to be allocated
5 to North Carolina Senior Living Association (NCSLA) and North Carolina
6 Assisted Living Association (NCALA). NCHCFA shall use its allocated funds
7 to purchase and distribute, free of charge, to licensed skilled nursing facilities;
8 and NCSLA and NCALA shall use its allocated funds to purchase and
9 distribute, free of charge, to licensed adult care homes and family care homes,
10 as those terms are defined in Article 1 of Chapter 131D of the General
11 Statutes, the following materials to their member facilities:

- 12 a. COVID-19 related supplies and equipment necessary for life safety,
13 health, and sanitation, such as ventilators, touch-free thermometers,
14 gowns, disinfectant, and sanitizing wipes.
15 b. Personal protective equipment, such as surgical and respiratory masks
16 and gloves, that meets Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
17 standards and guidelines.

18 NCSLA and NCALA shall collaborate together to assure equitable
19 distribution of the materials described in this subdivision to adult care homes
20 and family care homes. By February 1, 2021, NCSLA, NCHCFA, and
21 NCALA shall each submit a report on their use of these allocated funds to the
22 Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services and the
23 Fiscal Research Division."
