Budget and Management the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for	
the 2021-2022 fiscal year and the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in nonrecurring funds	
for the 2022-2023 fiscal year to be allocated to the Cape Fear Regional Theatre at Fayetteville,	
Inc., (CFRT) a nonprofit organization, to renovate and transform the regional theatre in
