indicating that it is only for electric vehicle charging and (ii) the signage must be consistent w	
the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, published by	
United States Department of Transportation, and any supplement to that Manual adopted by	
North Carolina Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
