1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWNS OF
3 RIVER BEND AND TRENT WOODS SHALL BE HELD IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS
4 AND TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF TOWN OFFICERS ELECTED IN 2019 BY ONE
5 YEAR.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.(a)** The Charter of the Town of Trent Woods, being Chapter 718 of the
8 1959 Session Laws, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 264 of the 1971 Session Laws and
9 Section 2 of Chapter 947 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

10 "Section 1. That certain area of Craven County, North Carolina, described in Section 2 below
11 is hereby incorporated under the name "Trent Woods" and the same is hereby created a body
12 politic and corporate; and shall hereafter possess all of the corporate powers and be subject to all
13 of the provisions contained in Chapter 160 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

15 "~~Sec. 3. The officers of said municipality shall consist of a mayor and three~~
16 ~~commissioners.~~**Regular Municipal Elections.** In 2022, regular municipal elections shall be held
17 in each even-numbered year in accordance with the uniform municipal election laws of North
18 Carolina.

19 "~~Sec. 4. Until their successors shall be elected and qualified pursuant to the provisions of~~
20 ~~Chapter 160, Article 3, of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following persons shall be~~
21 ~~and are hereby constituted the officers of said town, to wit: Mayor, George R. Scott;~~
22 ~~Commissioners, C. Stroud Tilley, George T. Burnette, Jr., and G. C. Honeycutt.~~**Election of**
23 **Mayor and Commissioners.** The officers of the Town shall consist of a mayor and three
24 commissioners elected to serve two-year terms and until their successors are elected and
25 qualified. In 2022, and biennially thereafter, the Mayor and three commissioners shall be elected
26 to serve two-year terms.

28 **SECTION 1.(b)** No municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of Trent
29 Woods in 2021. The two-year terms of the Mayor and three commissioners elected in 2019 are
30 extended by one year until 2022. Regular municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of
31 Trent Woods in 2022.

32 **SECTION 2.(a)** Section III of the Charter of the Town of River Bend, being that
33 Charter approved by the Municipal Board of Control and filed with the Secretary of State on
34 January 14, 1981, reads as rewritten:

35 "Section III – Composition and Mode of Election of City Council.

- 1 (1) The City Council shall consist of ~~3~~three members. Members of the City
2 Council shall serve terms of two years. All candidates shall be nominated and
3 elected by all the qualified voters of the city.
- 4 (2) Non-partisan, runoff municipal elections shall be held by the County Board of
5 Elections ~~pursuant to Article 23 and 24 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes~~
6 ~~of North Carolina and shall be conducted as provided in G.S. 163-293. in~~
7 ~~even-numbered years in accordance with Chapter 163 of the General Statutes.~~
- 8 (3) The Mayor shall be elected by all of the qualified voters to serve a two year
9 term. The Mayor has the right to vote only where there is a tie vote excluding
10 ~~his~~the Mayor's vote or where the issue is the appointment of officers. The
11 Mayor has no right to break a tie vote in which ~~he~~the Mayor participates.
- 12 ~~The first municipal election shall be held in conjunction with the incorporation~~
13 ~~referendum. The members of the City Council, then elected, shall serve until the next regular~~
14 ~~municipal election which shall be held on the fourth Tuesday before the Tuesday after the~~
15 ~~Monday in November of 1981, and the runoff election, if required, shall be held on Tuesday after~~
16 ~~the first Monday in November 1981, as per G.S. 163-279(4)."~~
- 17 **SECTION 2.(b)** No municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of River
18 Bend in 2021. The terms of office of the Mayor and all City Council members serving on the
19 effective date of this act shall be extended by one year, and regular municipal elections shall be
20 conducted in 2022 and every two years thereafter.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held
22 on or after that date.
