Senator Berger

1 moves to amend the bill on page 11, lines 3-12, by rewriting those lines to read:

2
3 "(b) Each local school administrative unit shall provide a signing bonus in an amount
4 determined by the local board of education that is at least one thousand two hundred dollars
5 (\$1,200) to any teacher who meets all of the following criteria:

6 (1) Is associated with high growth in reading based on EVAAS data.

7 (2) Was awarded a reading performance bonus administered by the Department
8 of Public Instruction.

9 (3) Accepts employment to provide instruction during a reading camp.

10 (c) Each local school administrative unit shall provide a reading camp performance bonus
11 to a teacher who provided instruction at a third grade reading camp in a per-student amount
12 determined by the local board of education that is at least one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for
13 each student not demonstrating reading proficiency assigned to that teacher who demonstrates
14 reading proficiency on an alternative assessment at the end of the reading camp.";

24 **"SECTION 7.(d)** To provide the signing bonus required under G.S. 115C-83.7A, as
25 enacted by this act, local school administrative units shall use the funds contained in Section
26 7A.1 of S.L. 2012-142, other than the funds provided for reading camps, and federal funds
27 received by a local school administrative unit for the purpose of responding to the impacts of
28 COVID-19. A reading performance bonus refers to a bonus awarded to third, fourth, or fifth
29 grade teachers based on EVAAS student growth index scores.

30 **SECTION 7.(e)** To provide the reading camp performance bonus required under
31 G.S. 115C-83.7A, as enacted by this act, local school administrative units shall use the funds
32 contained in Section 7A.1 of S.L. 2012-142, other than the funds provided for reading camps,
