(b) The Legislative Services Commission shall implement an annual training program on implicit bias for legislators and legislative employees to help them recognize implicit bias, understand the root of implicit biases, and become skilled in ways to counter implicit bias that impacts interactions, activities, and decision making in the legislative workplace. The implicit bias training program shall include both in-person training and remote on-demand components to maximize availability and effectiveness. The annual implicit bias training shall be mandatory for all legislators and legislative employees."		
SECTION 2.(a) G.S. 126-4 reads as rewritten: "§ 126-4. Powers and duties of State Human Resources Commission. Subject to the approval of the Governor, the State Human Resources Commission shall establish policies and rules governing each of the following:

SECTION 2.(b) G.S. 126-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(c17) The annual implicit bias training requirements adopted by the State Human Resources		
Commission pursuant to G.S. 126-4(20) shall apply to all State employees, including employees of the judicial branch, the Council of State agencies, and The University of North Carolina."		
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
