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Life Insurance Beneficiary Changes. Sponsors: Referred to: April 7, 2021 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW A CHANGE OF BENEFICIARY UNDER A LIFE INSURANCE POLICY IF THAT BENEFICIARY WAS SELECTED UNDER FRAUDULENT CIRCUMSTANCES OR FALSE PRETENSES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Part 3 of Article 58 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 58-58-96. Ability to change beneficiary. No life insurance company in this State shall prohibit the owner of a life insurance policy from making a change to a beneficiary, other than an irrevocable beneficiary, of that owner's policy if the current beneficiary was selected under fraudulent circumstances or false pretenses." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to life insurance

policies issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
