22			and explanation of those terms.
23		<u>e.</u>	An electronic mail address, mailing address, toll-free telephone
24			number, or another cost-effective, timely, and easy-to-use mechanism
25			that the consumer may use to terminate the automatic renewal. A
26			consumer who enters into a contract online shall be permitted to cancel
27			the contract online.
28	<u>(1a)</u>		n the consumer's affirmative consent before charging the consumer for

16	issued by a political subdivision of the State or an agency thereof.

18	(f) For purposes of this section, the term "automatic renewal provision" means a			
19	provision under which a contract is automatically renewed at the end of a definite term for a			
20	subsequent term of more than one month. Such renewal is effective unless the consumer gives			
21	notice to the seller of the consumer's intention to terminate the contract."			
22	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2022, and applies to contracts			
23	entered into on or after that date.
