Short Title: Volunteer EMS Providers/Grant Program. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY  
3 MANAGEMENT TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS THAT  
4 PROVIDE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND ASSISTANCE SERVICES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Appropriation. – There is appropriated five hundred thousand dollars  
7 (\$500,000) in nonrecurring funds from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety,  
8 Division of Emergency Management (Division), to provide grants to governmental entities and  
9 organizations exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue  
10 Code that provide emergency management and assistance services in this State. Any funds  
11 received under this section shall be subject to the requirements in G.S. 143C-6-22. The Division  
12 shall develop policies and procedures for the disbursement of the grants that include, at a  
13 minimum, the following:

- 14 (1) The maximum grant amount provided to any entity under this section shall be  
15 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).  
16 (2) The Division may use up to one percent (1%) of the funds appropriated by this  
17 act for administrative expenses related to administration of the grants  
18 authorized by this act.  
19 (3) The Division shall prioritize governmental entities and organizations that are  
20 located in development tier one and tier two areas, as defined in  
21 G.S. 143B-437.08.

22 **SECTION 2.** Report Requirements. – The Department of Public Safety, Division of  
23 Emergency Management, shall report to the Joint Legislative Emergency Management Oversight  
24 Committee and the Fiscal Research Division by November 1, 2021, on its distribution of the  
25 funds appropriated by this act and by June 30, 2022, on the use of funds by recipients.

26 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2021, and applies to grants on or  
27 after that date.
