SECTION 1.(b) G.S. 115C-12 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: 1 2 "(9e) Duty to Inform the Public About Instructional Materials. – The Board shall 3 ensure that information about instructional materials for any school operated 4 under Article 7A and Article 9C of this Chapter is prominently displayed on 5 the website of the school, as required by G.S. 115C-98A." 6 **SECTION 1.(c)** G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: 7 "(58a) To Inform the Public About Instructional Materials. - Local boards of 8 education shall ensure that information about instructional materials for each 9 school in the local school administrative unit is prominently displayed on the website of the school, as required by G.S. 115C-98A." 10 **SECTION 1.(d)** G.S. 115C-238.66 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: 11 12 "(11a) Instructional materials. – The board of directors shall ensure that information about instructional materials is prominently displayed on the website of the 13 14 regional school, in accordance with G.S. 115C-98A." **SECTION 1.(e)** G.S. 115C-218.85 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 15 Instructional Materials – A charter school shall ensure that information about 16 "(c) 17 instructional materials is prominently displayed on the website of the regional school, in accordance with G.S. 115C-98A." 18 **SECTION 2.** Article 2 of Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended by 19 20 adding the following new section to read: 21 "§ 115D-20.3. - Each constituent institution of The University of North Carolina shall prominently 1 (a) 2 display on the institution's website at least 15 days before the start of each academic semester at 3 least the following information organized by course offering for the upcoming academic semester 4 and from the prior academic year: 5 (1) The instructional materials used by and activities at the constituent institution, 6 including all of the following: 7 Assignments that are distributed or otherwise presented in any course 8 for which a student receives credit. Any instructional materials students may select when one or more 9 <u>b.</u> 10 instructional materials are available, if the selection of instructional 11 materials is restricted by the constituent institution. SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act applies beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. Sections 2 and 3 of this act apply beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year.
