(Public) Sponsors: Referred to: May 3, 2021 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO ENSURE ACADEMIC TRANSPARENCY. 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding 5 a new section to read: 6 "§ 115C-102.1. Inform the public about instructional materials. 7 The following definitions apply in this section: (a) 8 (1)Instructional material. - Any material used for instruction, including, but not 9 limited to, all textbooks, other reading materials, videos, digital materials, 10 websites, and other online applications. 11 Lesson plan. – An outline of all of the following: (2)The instruction provided by a teacher for a course that includes a list 12 a. of (i) all instructional materials assigned, distributed, or otherwise 13 14 presented in the course and (ii) when students must select instructional 15 materials from a defined list, all instructional materials on that list. Each grade- or school-wide presentation, assembly, lecture, or other 16 b. activity or event facilitated by the school during instructional hours 17 18 outside of an individual teacher's classroom, excluding student presentations. The outline shall include a list of (i) each presenter by 19 20 name and organization and (ii) any instructional material used or 21 presented. 22 The governing body of a public school unit shall ensure that the following information (b) 23 for each school it governs is prominently displayed on the school website, organized, at a 24 minimum, by subject area and grade level: 25 The lesson plans that were used at the school during the prior school year. (1)Lesson plans shall identify, at a minimum, (i) all instructional materials by the 26 27 title and the author, organization, or website associated with each material and activity, (ii) a brief descriptor of the instructional material, and (iii) a link to 28 the instructional material, if publicly available on the internet, or information 29 30 on how to request review of a copy of the instructional material in person. If 31 individual components of instructional materials used throughout the lesson 32 plan are produced as a single volume, that volume may be listed only once in 33 the lesson plan. If the instructional material was created by the teacher, the 34 lesson plan shall identify the teacher as the author. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the digital reproduction or posting of copies of 35 36 the instructional materials themselves.
