5	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-11 reads as rewritten:	
6	"§ 20-11. Issuar	nce of limited learner's permit and provisional drivers license to person who
7	is les	s than 18 years old.

9	(d) Level	2. – A person who is at least 16 years old but less than 18 years old may obtain
10	a limited provisional license if the person meets all of the following requirements:	
11	(1)	Has held a limited learner's permit issued by the Division for at least <u>12-nine</u>
12		months.
13	(2)	Has not been convicted of a motor vehicle moving violation or seat belt
14		infraction or a violation of G.S. 20-137.3 during the preceding six months.
15	(3)	Passes a road test administered by the Division.
16	(4)	Has a driving eligibility certificate or a high school diploma or its equivalent.
17	(5)	Has completed a driving log, on a form approved by the Division, detailing a
18		minimum of 60 hours as the operator of a motor vehicle of a class for which
19		the driver has been issued a limited learner's permit. The log must show at
20		least 10 hours of the required driving occurred during nighttime hours. No
21		more than 10 hours of driving per week may be counted toward the 60-hour
22		requirement. The driving log must be signed by the supervising driver and
23		submitted to the Division at the time the applicant seeks to obtain a limited
24		provisional license. If the Division has cause to believe that a driving log has
25		been falsified, the limited learner's permit holder shall be required to complete
26		a new driving log with the same requirements and shall not be eligible to
27		obtain a limited provisional license for six months.

29	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to applications	
30	for licenses submitted on or after that date. Section 1 of this act expires on December 31, 2021.
