1 moves to amend the bill on page 4, lines 49-50, by inserting between those lines:

3 **"HATTERAS/OCRACOKE FERRY LEASE**

4 **SECTION 9.1.** Notwithstanding Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes,
5 G.S. 136-28.1, and any other provision of law to the contrary, the Department of Transportation,
6 Ferry Division, shall lease a passenger ferry vessel for operation between Hatteras and Ocracoke.
7 The term of the lease shall end no later than September 12, 2021. Of the funds appropriated in
8 S.L. 2020-91 from the Highway Fund to the Department of Transportation, the sum of nine
9 hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$943,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be used by the
10 Division to lease and operate the ferry.

12 **REIMBURSEMENT OF CARTERET COUNTY**

13 **SECTION 9.2.** Of the funds appropriated in S.L. 2020-91 from the Highway Fund to
14 the Department of Transportation, the sum of sixty-two thousand nine hundred seventeen dollars
15 (\$62,917) in nonrecurring funds shall be used to reimburse funds provided by Carteret County
16 on behalf of Hyde County to fulfill the local match requirements for grant funds to dredge the
17 Cedar Island ferry channel.

19 **DREDGING FUNDS**

20 **SECTION 9.3.** Of the funds appropriated in S.L. 2020-91 from the Highway Fund
21 to the Department of Transportation, the sum of three hundred sixty-two thousand dollars
22 (\$362,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be used for North Carolina coastal dredging."
