(1) A low-speed vehicle may be operated only on streets and highway posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less. A mini-truck or more vehicle may be operated only on streets and highways where the plimit is 55 miles per hour or less. less; provided, a modified utility not be operated on any street or highway having four or more unless the posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less. This does not prohibit a low-speed vehicle, mini-truck, or modified ut from crossing a road or street at an intersection where the road or crossed has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour. (4) The Notwithstanding the provisions of any other subdivision of this section, the Department of Transportation may prohibit the operation of low-speed vehicles, mini-trucks, or modified utility vehicles on any road or highway if it determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety.
