A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PUNISHMENT FOR ALTERING, DESTROYING, OF REMOVING PERMANENT PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION MARKS FROM PERSONAL PROPERTY AND REMOVING, DEFACING, DESTROYING, ALTERING OR COVERING OVER IDENTIFYING MARKS ON CERTAIN MACHINERY EQUIPMENT, AND APPARATUSES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-160.1(c) reads as rewritten:

SECTION 2. G.S. 14-401.4(d) reads as rewritten:
"(d) Any—Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any person, firm—firm, o corporation who shall violate any part of this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. I the machine or other apparatus was valued at one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more at the time of the offense, then the person, firm, or corporation shall be guilty of a Class H felony."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses

committed on or after that date.
