1 moves to amend the bill on page 22, lines 14-29, by rewriting the lines to read:

3 **""§ 14-223. Resisting officers.**

4 (a) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully resist, delay or obstruct a public officer
5 in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his office, he shall be an official duty, the
6 person is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.

7 (b) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully resist, delay or obstruct a public officer
8 in discharging or attempting to discharge an official duty, and the resistance, delay or obstruction
9 is the proximate cause of a public officer's serious injury, the person is guilty of a Class I felony.

10 (c) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully resist, delay or obstruct a public officer
11 in discharging or attempting to discharge an official duty, and the resistance, delay or obstruction
12 is the proximate cause of a public officer's serious bodily injury, the person is guilty of a Class F
13 felony.

14 (d) "Serious bodily injury" is defined as bodily injury that creates a substantial risk of
15 death, or that causes serious permanent disfigurement, coma, a permanent or protracted condition
16 that causes extreme pain, or permanent or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any
17 bodily member or organ, or that results in prolonged hospitalization."
