2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PUNISHMENT FOR ALTERING, DESTROYING, OR
3	REMOVING PERMANENT PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION MARKS FROM
4	PERSONAL PROPERTY AND REMOVING, DEFACING, DESTROYING, ALTERING,
5	OR COVERING OVER IDENTIFYING MARKS ON CERTAIN MACHINERY,
6	EQUIPMENT, AND APPARATUSES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-160.1(c) reads as rewritten:
9	"(c) Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater
10	punishment, a violation of any of the provisions of this section shall be (i) a Class 1
11	misdemeanor.misdemeanor if the personal property was valued at not more than one thousand
12	dollars (\$1,000) at the time of the offense or (ii) a Class H felony if the personal property was
13	valued at more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) at the time of the offense."
14	SECTION 2. G.S. 14-401.4(d) reads as rewritten:
15	"(d) Any Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any person, firm firm, or
16	corporation who shall violate any part of this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. If
17	the machine or other apparatus was valued at more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) at the time
18	of the offense, then the person, firm, or corporation shall be guilty of a Class H felony."
19	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses
20	committed on or after that date.
