1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 2-3, by rewriting those lines to read:

3 "AN ACT TO STUDY THE INSTALLATION OF CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM AND  
4 DETECTION SYSTEMS IN EXISTING PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS, TO";

6 and on page 1, lines 8-23, by rewriting those lines to read:

7 "SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall survey all public school units to  
8 determine the number of existing school buildings that are currently not equipped with carbon  
9 monoxide alarm and detection systems, but would have to install those systems if required to be  
10 in compliance with the requirements for new buildings in Section 915 of the North Carolina State  
11 Building Code, Fire Prevention Code (non-equipped buildings). The State Board of Education  
12 shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee, House Appropriations  
13 Committee, and Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee the following information no  
14 later than December 15, 2021:

- 15 (1) The number of non-equipped buildings statewide, and by public school unit.  
16 (2) The estimated cost statewide, and by public school unit, to permit, install, and  
17 inspect all non-equipped buildings with carbon monoxide alarm and detection  
18 systems."
