Representative Hurley

1 moves to amend the bill on page 10, lines 10-11, by inserting the following between those lines:

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### "NORTH CAROLINA GLOBAL TRANSPARK AUTHORITY

**SECTION 25.1** G.S. 63A-3(b) reads as rewritten:

5 "(b) Board of Directors. – The Authority shall be governed by a Board of Directors. The 6 Board shall consist of at least the following 20 members:

- (1) Six members appointed by the Governor. One member shall be representative of the economic development industry, two members shall be representative of the commercial real estate development industry, two members shall be representative of the banking and finance industry, and one member shall be representative of environmental interests. Of the Governor's six appointments, at least one member shall come from each of the State's three regions: Western, Piedmont, and Eastern.
- (2) Three members appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in accordance with G.S. 120-121. One member shall be representative of the aerospace and aviation industry, one member shall be representative of advanced manufacturing industries, and one member shall be representative of the logistics and supply chain management industry.
- (3) Three members appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in accordance with G.S. 120-121. One member shall be representative of the aerospace and aviation industry, one member shall be representative of the emergency response and disaster relief industries, and one member shall be representative of the defense and security industry.
  - (4) The State Treasurer, who shall serve as an ex officio nonvoting member.
- (5) The President of the North Carolina System of Community Colleges, Colleges or the President's designee, provided that the President of the North Carolina Community Colleges may instead appoint to the Board of Directors one member of the board of trustees of a community college or one president of a community college. If such an appointment is made, the appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the President.



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The President of The University of North Carolina, Carolina or the President's (6) 1 designee, provided that the President of the University of North Carolina may 2 3 instead appoint to the Board of Directors one member of the board of trustees of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina, or one 4 chancellor of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina. If 5 such an appointment is made, the appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the 6 President. 7 The Chairman of the State Ports Authority. 8 (7)One member appointed by the board of county commissioners of any county 9 (8) in which the cargo airport complex site is located. 10 One member appointed by the city council of the city which is a county seat 11 (9) of any county in which the cargo airport complex site is located. 12 The Commissioner of Agriculture. Agriculture or the Commissioner's 13 (10)14 designee. The Secretary of the Department of Commerce.Commerce or the Secretary's 15 (11)designee. 16 17 Within 90 days after the Authority acquires land, either by purchase or condemnation, for development as part of a cargo airport complex site, the board of county commissioners in any 18 county in which a portion of the land is located and the city council of the city which is the county 19 seat of the county shall, by resolution, each appoint a person to serve as a member of the Board. 20 If the board of commissioners or the city council appoints one of its own members to the Board, 21 the county commissioner or the member of the city council who is appointed is considered to be 22 23 serving on the Board as an ex officio voting member as part of the duties of the office of county commissioner or the office of city council member, in accordance with G.S. 128-1.2, and is not 24 considered to be serving in a separate office. Notwithstanding G.S. 116-31(h), a member of the 25 board of trustees of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina appointed to the 26 Board of Directors under subdivision (6) of this subsection may concurrently serve on the board 27 of trustees and the Board of Directors. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor 28 may serve on the Board of Directors by his own appointment on or after July 16, 1991, under 29 subdivision (1) of this subsection. 30 As the holder of an office, each member of the Board shall take the oath required by Article 31 VI, § 7 of the North Carolina Constitution before assuming the duties of a Board member." 32 33 34 STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES ELECTIONS CHANGES 35 SECTION 25.2.(a) Article 1 of Chapter 115D of the General Statues is amended by adding a new section to read: 36 37 "§ 115D-2.2. State Board of Community Colleges. The State Board of Community Colleges is established. 38 (a) 39 The State Board of Community Colleges shall consist of 22 members, as follows: (b) The Lieutenant Governor or the Lieutenant Governor's designee shall be a 40 (1)member ex officio. 41 The Treasurer of North Carolina or the Treasurer's designee shall be a member 42 (2)43 ex officio.

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1	<u>(3)</u>	The Commissioner of Labor or the Commissioner's designee shall be a
2		member ex officio.
3	<u>(4)</u>	The Governor shall appoint to the State Board four members from the State at
4		large and one member from each of the six Trustee Association Regions
5		defined in G.S. 115D-62. Each appointment by the Governor shall be for a
6		term of four years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. Any
7		vacancy occurring among the Governor's appointees before the expiration of
8		term shall be filled by appointment of the Governor. The member appointed
9		to fill a vacancy shall meet the same residential gualification, if any, as the
10		vacating member and shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of
11		that member.
12	<u>(5)</u>	The General Assembly shall elect eight members of the State Board from the
13		State at large to a term of four years and until a successor is elected and
14		qualifies. The Senate shall elect four members and the House of
15		Representatives shall elect four members in accordance with subsection (c) of
16		this section.
17	(6)	The person serving as president of the North Carolina Comprehensive
18		Community College Student Government Association shall be an ex officio
19		member of the State Board. If the president of the Association is unable for
20		any reason to serve as the student member of the State Board, then pursuant
21		to the constitution of the Association, the vice-president of the Association
22		shall serve as the student member of the State Board. Any person serving as
23		the student member of the State Board must be a student in good standing at
24		a North Carolina community college. The student member of the State Board
25		shall have all the rights and privileges of membership, except that the student
26		member shall not have a vote.
27	(c) <u>At eac</u>	th session of the General Assembly held in an odd-numbered year, the Senate
28	and the House of	Representatives shall select from a slate of candidates made in each chamber.
29	The slate shall be	prepared as provided by resolution in each chamber. If a sufficient number of
30	nominees who ar	e legally qualified are submitted, then the slate of candidates shall list at least
31	twice the number	of candidates for the total seats open. All qualified candidates shall compete
32		ualified candidates. All candidates shall submit a statement of economic interest

5	years on the State Board. Election or appointment to a partial term to fill a vacancy does not
6	count toward the term limitation.
7	(g) No member of the General Assembly, no officer or employee of the State, and no
8	officer or employee of an institution under the jurisdiction of the State Board shall be eligible to
9	serve on the State Board. No spouse of a member of the General Assembly or of an officer or
10	employee of the Community College System or of an institution under the jurisdiction of the
11	State Board shall be eligible to serve on the State Board. No person who within the prior five
12	years has been an employee of the Community Colleges System Office shall be eligible to serve
13	on the State Board.
14	(h) At its first meeting after July 1 of each odd numbered year, the State Board shall elect
15	from its membership a chair and such other officers as it may deem necessary.
16	(i) The State Board of Community Colleges shall meet at stated times established by the
17	State Board, but not less frequently than 10 times a year. The State Board of Community Colleges
18	shall also meet with the State Board of Education and the Board of Governors of The University
19	of North Carolina at least once a year to discuss educational matters of mutual interest and to
20	recommend to the General Assembly such policies as are appropriate to encourage the
21	improvement of public education at every level in this State; these joint meetings shall be hosted
22	by the three Boards according to the schedule set out in G.S. 115C-11(b1). Special meetings of
23	the State Board may be set at any regular meeting or may be called by the chair. A majority of
24	the qualified members of the State Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
25	(j) Whenever any vacancy shall occur in the appointed or elected membership of the
26	State Board, the chair shall inform the appropriate appointing or electing authority of the vacancy.
27	(k) The State Board of Community Colleges may declare vacant the office of an
28	appointed or elected member who does not attend three consecutive scheduled meetings without
29	justifiable excuse. The chair of the State Board shall notify the appropriate appointing or electing
30	authority of any vacancy."
31	<b>SECTION 25.2(b)</b> G.S. 115D-2.1 is repealed.
32	SECTION 25.2.(c) G.S. 138A-24(f) reads as rewritten:
33	"(f) The Commission shall prepare a written evaluation of each statement of economic
34	interest for nominees of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina elected
35	pursuant to G.S. 116-6, and nominees of the State Board of Community Colleges elected
36	pursuant to G.S. 115D-2.1-G.S. 115D-2.2 within seven days of the submission of the completed
37	statement of economic interest to the Commission."
38	SECTION 25.2.(d) Notwithstanding G.S. 115D-2.2, as enacted by this act, the
39	following shall be the terms of office for members elected or appointed in 2021:
40	(1) The House of Representatives shall elect two members to six-year terms.
41	(2) The Senate shall elect two members to six-year terms.
42	(3) The Governor shall appoint four members to six-year terms.



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1 2	<b>SECTION 25.2.(e)</b> Notwithstanding G.S. 115D-2.2, as enacted by this act, the following shall be the terms of office for members elected or appointed in 2023:	;				
3	(1) The House of Representatives shall elect one member to a two-year term.					
4	(2) The Senate shall elect one member to a two-year term.					
5	(3) The Governor shall appoint two members to two-year terms and one member	•				
6	to a four-year term.					
7	Upon the expiration of the terms elected and appointed in 2021 and 2023, all elections and	1				
8	appointments shall be for four-year terms, as required by G.S. 115D-2.2, as enacted by this act.					
9	SECTION 25.2.(f) This section is effective when it becomes law and applies					
10	beginning with the election or appointment of members to the State Board of Community					
11	Colleges to terms beginning on July 1, 2021.".
