- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 4, line 45, by increasing the requirements by one billion two
- 2 hundred thirty-eight million dollars (\$1,238,000,000) for the 2021-2022 fiscal year and by one
- 3 billion two hundred forty-eight million dollars (\$1,248,000,000) for the 2022-2023 fiscal year;
- 4 and

- 6 further moves to amend the bill on page 10, line 24, by decreasing the reduction for the 2022-
- 7 2023 fiscal year by five hundred fifty-four million five hundred ninety-two thousand six hundred
- 8 thirty dollars (\$554,592,630); and

- 10 further moves to amend the bill on page 10, line 40, by decreasing the amount for the 2021-2022
- 11 fiscal year by one billion two hundred thirty-eight million dollars (\$1,238,000,000) and for the
- 12 2022-2023 fiscal year by one billion nine hundred thirty-one million four hundred seven thousand
- 13 three hundred seventy dollars (\$1,931,407,370); and

- 15 further moves to amend the bill on page 10, line 51 through page 11, lines 1-2, by deleting the
- 16 phrase "one billion five hundred forty-five million five hundred forty-five thousand four hundred
- 17 fifty-three dollars (\$1,545,545,453)" and substituting "nine hundred ninety million nine hundred
- 18 fifty-two thousand eight hundred twenty-three dollars (\$990,952,823)"; and

- 20 further moves to amend the bill on page 108, lines 38-51 through page 109, lines 1-5, by rewriting
- 21 the lines to read:
- 22 **"SECTION 9C.1.(a) Eligibility.** – The Department of Health and Human Services,
- 23 Division of Child Development and Early Education (Division), shall continue implementing the
- 24 prekindergarten (NC Pre-K) program. However, beginning with the 2021-2022 school calendar
- 25 year and thereafter, the NC Pre-K program shall be expanded to include children who are 3 years
- 26 of age and shall serve children who are 3 or 4 years of age on or before August 31 of the program
- 27 year. Except for requiring that the NC Pre-K program serve children who are 3 or 4 years of age
- 28 on or before August 31 of the program year, the Division shall not require that a child seeking to
- 29 participate in the NC Pre-K program meet any other eligibility requirements."; and

- 31 further moves to amend the bill on page 109, lines 33-34, by inserting between those lines the
- 32 following new section to read:

1 **"FUNDS FOR UNIVERSAL NC PRE-K/EXPAND TO 3 YEAR-OLDS**
2 **SECTION 9C.1A.** Notwithstanding the Committee Report referenced in Section
3 43.2 of this act or any other provision of law to the contrary, funds appropriated in this act to the
4 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education,
5 are increased by the sum of one billion two hundred thirty-eight million dollars (\$1,238,000,000)
6 in recurring funds for the 2021-2022 fiscal year and the sum of one billion two hundred forty-
7 eight million dollars (\$1,248,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. These
8 funds shall be used for all children who are 3 or 4 years of age in this State to participate in the
9 North Carolina Prekindergarten (NC Pre-K) program in accordance with Section 9C.1 of this
10 act."; and

12 further moves to amend the bill on page 390, lines 20-34, by deleting those lines; and

14 by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
