1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 8, by inserting the following at the end of the line before  
2 the period:  
3 "AND TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO PURCHASE  
4 PRIOR WEAPON USED";  
5  
6 and on page 1, lines 34-35, by inserting the following between the lines:  
7 "SECTION 1.5. G.S. 20-187.2 reads as rewritten:  
8 "**§ 20-187.2. Badges and service side arms of deceased or retiring members of State, city**  
9 **city, and county law enforcement law enforcement agencies; weapons of active**  
10 **members.**  
11 (a) Surviving spouses, or in the event such members die unsurvived by a spouse,  
12 surviving children of members of North Carolina State, city city, and county law enforcement  
13 law enforcement agencies killed in the line of duty or who are members of such agencies at the  
14 time of their deaths, and retiring members of such agencies shall receive upon request and at no  
15 cost to them, the badge worn or carried by such deceased or retiring member. The governing  
16 body of a law enforcement law enforcement agency may, in its discretion, also award to a retiring  
17 member or surviving relatives as provided herein, upon request, the service side arm of such  
18 deceased or retiring members, at a price determined by such governing body, upon determining  
19 that the person receiving the weapon is not ineligible to own, possess, or receive a firearm under  
20 the provisions of State or federal law, or if the weapon has been rendered incapable of being  
21 fired. Governing body shall mean for county and local alcohol beverage control officers, the  
22 county or local board of alcoholic control; for all other law enforcement law enforcement officers  
23 with jurisdiction limited to a municipality or town, the city or town council; for all other  
24 law enforcement law enforcement officers with countywide jurisdiction, the board of county  
25 commissioners; for all State law enforcement law enforcement officers, the head of the  
26 department.  
27 (b) Active members of North Carolina State law enforcement State, city, and county law  
28 enforcement agencies, upon change of type of weapons, may purchase the weapon worn or  
29 carried by such member at a price which shall be the average yield to the State State, city, or  
30 county from the sale of similar weapons during the preceding year.
