Representative McNeely

1 moves to amend the bill on page 199, lines 30-31, by inserting the following language between  
2 those lines:

3 **"STUDENT BEEKEEPING GRANT PROGRAM**

4 **SECTION 8.20.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act or the Committee  
5 Report described in Section 43.2 of this act, of the funds appropriated by this act to the Board of  
6 Governors of The University of North Carolina for the 2022-2023 fiscal year for the North  
7 Carolina Food Innovation Laboratory at the NC Research Campus in Kannapolis, the sum of one  
8 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year  
9 shall be allocated to North Carolina State University (NC State University) for the provision of  
10 grants to create beekeeping programs for high school chapters of Future Farmers of America  
11 (FFA) located in the State.

12 **SECTION 8.20.(b)** NC State University shall include the following in the grant  
13 program funded by this section:

- 14 (1) Expenses eligible for funding from a grant under this section shall include the  
15 purchase of any of the following:
  - 16 a. Woodenware and other materials necessary to house honeybee  
17 colonies, including hive bodies, supers, top and bottom boards, inner  
18 covers, and frames.
  - 19 b. Protective gear and other equipment necessary for the practice of  
20 beekeeping.
  - 21 c. Queens, honeybee packages, and nucleus colonies.
  - 22 d. Eligible educational expenses for no more than two persons per grant.  
23 For purposes of this subdivision, an eligible educational expense  
24 means registration and materials for a course designed to assist the  
25 participant to become a beekeeper certified by the North Carolina State  
26 Beekeepers Association.
- 27 (2) NC State University shall ensure that no more than one thousand five hundred  
28 dollars (\$1,500) per county is available to FFA chapters at high schools in that  
29 county. FFA chapters shall be responsible for matching the grant received in  
30 a manner and amount as NC State University may specify.

- 1           (3)    NC State University shall provide for a recovery of the grant award if the  
2                    beekeeping program funded by the grant is not maintained for at least three  
3                    school years.  
4           (4)    Of the funds appropriated by this section, NC State University may spend up  
5                    to fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for administrative costs, including the  
6                    costs of promoting the program to potential grantees.";
