Representative McNeely

1 moves to amend the bill on page 334, lines 31-47, by rewriting those lines to read:

2 "SECTION 10.8.(d) Eligibility Requirements. – An eligible applicant is a swine or  
3 dairy producer that provides to the Department the following information demonstrating the  
4 applicant's eligibility for financial assistance pursuant to this section:

5 (1) For swine producers in the State, all of the following:

6 a. A contract termination letter from a swine integrator or other  
7 documentation of contract termination between March 1, 2020, and  
8 June 30, 2022.

9 b. Proof that the swine operation is permitted by the State.

10 c. Any other information deemed appropriate by the Department.

11 (2) For dairy producers in the State, proof that the dairy operation was permitted  
12 as a Grade A milk producer by the Food and Drug Protection Division of the  
13 Department during the relevant eligibility time period, any other information  
14 deemed appropriate by the Department and either (i) proof of enrollment in  
15 the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Dairy Margin Coverage (DMC) program  
16 for the 2021 program year, or (ii) milk production records, showing ceased  
17 production during any time between March 1, 2020, and June 30, 2022."; and  
18

19 on page 335, lines 18-19, by inserting between those lines the following language:

20 "3. For applicants showing eligibility by showing proof of  
21 enrollment in the DMC program under subdivision (d)(2),  
22 reimbursement for their costs of enrollment in the program for  
23 the 2021 program year."
