A report completed by an 5 Investigator shall be treated the same as if it were completed by a law 6 enforcement officer for purposes of G.S. 20-166.1(i). A law enforcement 7 officer shall investigate any crash involving personal injury or a fatality. 8 Investigators shall have the same authority as a law enforcement officer to tow <u>(9)</u> 9 or remove a vehicle that is obstructing a public street or highway. 10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Investigators shall have the same (10)11 authority as a law enforcement officer to direct all traffic in conformance with law and, in the event of a fire or other emergency or to expedite traffic or to 12 13 ensure safety, to direct traffic as conditions may require." 14 **SECTION 1.(b)** Not later than December 31, 2023, the City of Greenville shall 15 submit to the House of Representatives Appropriations Subcommittee on Justice and Public 16

Safety and the Senate Committee on Appropriations on Justice and Public Safety a written report on the training and use of Traffic Crash Investigators, as authorized in Section 1(a) of this act, for the period commencing on the effective date of this act and concluding November 1, 2023.

**SECTION 2.** Section 8 of S.L. 2007-218 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 8. SECTION 8.(a) A Civilian Traffic Investigator shall have no authority to arrest or issue criminal process, process, except citations pursuant to subsection (b) of this section. A Civilian Traffic Investigator shall not be issued a weapon of any type.

"SECTION 8.(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a Civilian Traffic Investigator shall have the authority to issue citations for infractions under Chapter 20 of the General Statutes related to the traffic crashes that the Civilian Traffic Investigator investigates."

**SECTION 3.** S.L. 2007-218 is amended by adding a new section to read as follows: "SECTION 9A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a Civilian Traffic Investigator shall have the same authority as a law enforcement officer to direct all traffic in conformance with law and, in the event of a fire or other emergency or to expedite traffic or to ensure safety, to direct traffic as conditions may require."

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
