The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Williamston the nonrecurring sum of twenty-nine million nine hundred thousand dollars	
(\$29,900,000) for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. Funds appropriated in this act do not revert but	
remain available to the town for the purposes allowed in this act. Of the amount appropriated in	
this section, the town shall use the following amounts in the following ways:

	watershed improvements, and wastewater system equipment and improvements, and for operating grants and loan forgiveness for the Martin

	charging stations, energy efficiency initiatives, and electric vehicle and solar equipment purchases for town departments.
