 - (3) Timely updates to any operational or admissions information, as determined by the Division.
 - (d) Failure to participate in the BH SCAN in accordance with all requirements under this section results in noncompliance with this section. Noncompliance with this section results in a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day for each day in which the entity is out of compliance with this section. The Division may waive any fine if the noncompliance was a result of no-fault technical complications."

SECTION 1.(b) This section is effective October 1, 2022.

SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2022, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in nonrecurring funds to be used to facilitate connections to the North Carolina Behavioral Health Crisis Referral System and to communicate the requirements imposed due to implementation of this act.

SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes law.
