21	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of			
22	Public Safety the sum of one million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) in recurring			
23	funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year to be used to administer the Assistance Program for Victims			
24	of Rape and Sex Offenses in accordance with this act.			
25	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2022, and applies to forensic			

medical examinations conducted on or after that date.
