**HOUSE BILL DRH10628-LUa-121**

Short Title: Continue Child Care Stabilization Grants. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO CONTINUE CHILD CARE STABILIZATION  
3 GRANTS.

4 Whereas, funding for child care stabilization grants is running out; and  
5 Whereas, the State continues to face a child care staffing and budget crisis; and  
6 Whereas, child care facilities in this State need to be staffed to allow parents to work  
7 and keep the economy going; Now, therefore,  
8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Department of Health  
10 and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of six  
11 hundred seventy-nine million dollars (\$679,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023  
12 fiscal year to provide continued funding for child care stabilization grants consistent with similar  
13 grants distributed in accordance with Section 3.2(a) of S.L. 2021-25. To receive funding under  
14 this section, a grant recipient shall submit a report to the Division on the efficacy of the grant  
15 funds within in one year from the date the recipient receives those funds.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2022.
