1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 12, by inserting the word "any" between the words "with"  
2 and "work";

4 and on page 1, lines 18-20, by rewriting the lines to read:

5 "SECTION 1.1.(c) This section is effective July 1, 2023, or on the date that the work  
6 requirements developed under Part II of this act become effective, whichever is earlier.";

7  
8 and on page 2, lines 44-46, by rewriting the lines to read:

9 "SECTION 1.2.(b) This section is effective July 1, 2023, or on the date that the work  
10 requirements developed under Part II of this act become effective, whichever is earlier.";

11  
12 and on page 3, lines 32-36, by rewriting those lines to read:

13 "SECTION 1.5.(d) Subsection (c) of this section becomes effective on the effective  
14 date of the Medicaid coverage described in Section 1.1 of this act and expires June 30, 2023. If  
15 the effective date occurs after March 31, 2023, then no assessment shall be imposed for the State  
16 fiscal quarter beginning January 1, 2023, and no payments shall be made to the county  
17 departments of social services for that quarter. If the effective date occurs after June 30, 2023,  
18 then no assessment shall be imposed under subsection (c) of this section, and no payments shall  
19 be made to the county departments of social services under subsection (c) of this section.";

21 and on page 6, line 48, by deleting the word "Certain" and substituting the phrase "It is the intent  
22 of the General Assembly that certain";

23  
24 and on page 6, line 50, by deleting the word "The" and inserting the phrase "To this end, the";

25  
26 and on 7, lines 23-27, by rewriting those lines to read:

27 "SECTION 2.(b) No later than 30 days after the effective date of this act, DHHS  
28 shall submit to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) any waiver necessary to implement  
29 the work requirements developed and that are intended to be a contingency for participation in  
30 NC Health Works under G.S. 108A-54.3A(24), as enacted by Section 1.1 of this act. DHHS shall  
31 request an effective date that is no later than six months from the effective date of this act. In the  
32 event that the initial submission is denied, DHHS shall continue to monitor developments on the



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- 1 federal level with regards to the imposition of work requirements as a contingency to eligibility
- 2 for Medicaid coverage and resubmit the waiver if there are new developments. Nothing in this
- 3 section shall preclude the pursuit of any legal action by the State related to federal approval or
- 4 disapproval of implementation of this section."
